

Making the *Angle Guide*

The *Angle Guide* is not conducive to downloading because it is larger than an 8.5X11" piece of paper and must be done on tracing paper. Provided here are directions for making your own *Angle Guide*.

1. On a piece of tracing paper, draw a circle with a radius of 11.5 cm.
2. Using a protractor for reference, mark 0/360, 30, 60, 90, 120, 150, 180, 210, 240, 270, 300, and 330-degrees along the circumference of the circle, as shown below.
3. Clearly mark the center of the circle.


